Concept Question

Are changes in national life and culture good?

What I will learn (sticky knowledge)

I know what it means to Christians to belong to a church.

I can talk about how Christians might use symbols in a church building and begin to suggest reasons why.

I can talk about my own experiences and link these to communities in which I belong.

I can explain what a Christian Baptism is.

What I should already know (EYFS)

Explain why Christians say Jesus is special.

Wonder why a minister pours water on babies in Baptism.

Talk about some things Christians might do in Church.

Encounter religion and world views through stories, special books, places, objects and events.



What I will learn next (Y2)

Explain why Christians might choose to follow Jesus.

Recall key teachings Christians believe about God found in the 'lost' parables, the parable of the Good Samaritan and other parables studied.

Describe key important things Christians believe about Jesus and refer to the Easter story, life and teachings of Jesus.

Evaluate key teachings studied from the Bible and explain why they may be important to Christians.

Key Vocabulary	Definition
Faith	A devotion to a duty or person, for Christians it is a belief, trust and loyalty to God.
Belong	To be a member or part of a group
Christian	Things that Christians have or wear to show that they belong to the church.
Symbols	
Jesus	Christians believe Jesus is God's Son, part of the Trinity of Father, Son and Holy Spirit. The Messiah and The Saviour.
Baptism	Infant baptism when babies are welcomed into the family of God, the church, Jesus' family
Cross	A key symbol of the Christian faith, as Jesus was crucified on one.
