Listen and Appraise:

I can find the pulse as I am listening to the music.

I can rap and sing Hey You! in groups.

I can use the notes C and G to play one or two notes on an instrument.

I can **improvise** using the notes C and G.

I can compose a simple melody using the notes C, D and E.

What I should already know

I can sing the melodic shape (moving melody, eg up and down, down & up) of familiar songs.

I can tap rhythms to accompany words, e.g. tapping the syllables of names/objects/ animals/lyrics of a song.

I can play instruments with control to play loud/quiet, (dynamics), fast/slow (tempo).

What I will learn next
