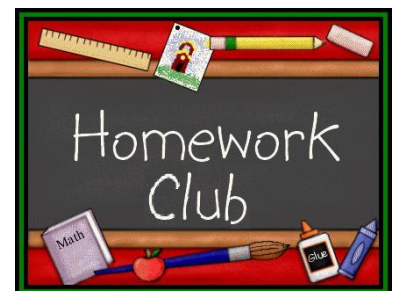
**2. Minutes and Matters Arising (Feedback)**
