What I should already know


- I know who Jesus was, why he taught through stories and why he is important to Christians today.

Key Vocabulary	
Belief	Part of belonging to a religion. The belief in certain ideas about right and wrong behavior and gods.
Faith	In any particular religion and its teachings.
Father	God is the Father.
God	the supreme being that is worshipped by Christians, Jews, and Muslims as the maker and ruler of the universe.
Heaven	The home of God where souls go after death.
Holy Spirit	The third member of the Holy Trinity-the holy ghost.
Philosophy	The study of the nature of life, truth, knowledge, and other important human matters,
Son	Jesus the son of god.
Symbols	Visual representations to express ideas and beliefs.
Three in one	The Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit.
Trinity	Symbols describing the nature of God as three distinct persons in one essence: God the Father, God the Son (Jesus Christ), and God the Holy Spirit.
