# REQUEST FOR TERM TIME ABSENCE FROM WILLOW WOOD COMMUNITY NURSERY & PRIMARY SCHOOL

Please note:

- Any absence within the academic year will be classed as unauthorised, unless the Headteacher has granted permission.
- We follow the guidelines which state that we may, in special circumstances, authorise an absence in term time.
- All absences for holidays will be unauthorised. If your child is on holiday for 10 consecutive days, you will receive a fine from the local authority. If 10 days' absence is accrued over a rolling 10 week period, you will receive a fine.
- Any requests for a 2<sup>nd</sup> absence within a 3 year period will be discussed at a meeting with The headteacher and the Attendance officer.
- Authorisation must be applied for at least 1 month in advance. Authorisation will not be given retrospectively.

#### Free School Meals and Pupil Premium

Your child may be able to get free school meals/pupil premium if you are in receipt of any of the following:

- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guaranteed element of Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
- Working Tax Credit run-on paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- Universal Credit if you apply on or after 1 April 2018 your household income must be less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get)

The criteria also applies if your child is adopted or under a special guardianship order. Please speak to the school office if you need any help with applying or have any questions. It is important that you register, even if your child currently receives Universal Free Infant School Meals as there is additional funding (Pupil Premium) that school can apply for <u>https://www.gov.uk/apply-free-</u> <u>school-meals</u>
